

Form 6 Full and Public Disclosure of Financial Interests for calendar year 2023

The Florida Legislature changed the procedure for candidates running for an elected position who are required to file a Form 6 Financial Disclosure as part of their qualifying for office.

The new law requires candidates to file their disclosure online, directly with the Florida Commission on Ethics, and then submit a printed copy to the Supervisor of Elections as part of their qualifying. Incumbents may file a receipt of filing to fulfill the requirement.

Candidates may register with the Florida Commission on Ethics and complete their Form 6 online using the website below:

Section 112.31445, Florida Statutes, requires that all Form 6 Full and Public Disclosure of Financial Interests, other than those of judges and judges of compensation claims, be posted online. Therefore, please be advised that your completed Form 6 will appear publicly on the Florida Commission on Ethics website.

Candidates for County Commission, School Board and County Judge are required to file a Form 6 as part of their qualifying for ballot position. Other offices require a Form 1.
