

GUIDELINES FOR THE FLORIDA STATE ASSOCIATION OF SUPERVISORS OF ELECTIONS SCHOLARSHIP STUDENT ELIGIBILITY

STUDENT ELIGIBILITY - To be eligible for the FSASE Scholarship, the student applicant shall:

- Be a Political Science, Public or Business Administration, or Journalism/Mass Communication major.
- Be a citizen of the United States.
- Have been a bonafide resident of Florida for two years preceding the academic year for which application is made.
- Be enrolled or accepted as a full-time student in a senior college or university in Florida. No postgraduate or second-degree students.
- Have finished two years of junior college or undergraduate work (enough credits for enrollment as a junior).
- Submit two current letters of recommendation:
 - one from a teacher or anyone from the college or university currently attending or the college or university you graduated from
 - one from a citizen of good standing in your home community.
- Submit a resume of your high school and/or college activities as well as what you have done for your community.
- Demonstrate a financial need and furnish a financial statement that shows what your own contribution is to your educational expenses.
- Have maintained a “C” average or above for the previous year.
- Be available for a personal interview by the Supervisor of Elections in the county where you are a registered voter.
- **BE REGISTERED TO VOTE.** (Written verification required by Supervisor submitting application).

ELIGIBLE INSTITUTION - Scholarship must be given to student attending a Florida university or college which is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools.

STIPULATION - The scholarship check will be made payable to the winning applicant AND to the school which they will be attending.

STUDENT:

- Must apply in accordance with all eligibility requirements. (Failure to do so could result in non-consideration).
- Must continue to meet all initial eligibility requirements.
- Must maintain a “C” average or above.
- Must remain in good standing at the institution.

APPLICATION: Must be received by the Supervisor of Elections in the county where you are a registered voter by March 19, 2010. Letters of recommendation **MUST ACCOMPANY THE APPLICATION OR BE RECEIVED BY THE March 19 DEADLINE.**

SELECTION - Each County’s Supervisor will review all applications and select a finalist to be sent to the FSASE Scholarship Committee, along with a written opinion of the applicant. The FSASE Scholarship Committee will select three winners (\$1,200 each) from the finalists submitted. Past recipients may re-apply again the second year.
